Now That You Are Four Weeks From Your Due Date...

Please phone the office during the day or the Answering Service at 258-1919 at night if:

1) Contractions are:

****Every 5 minutes lasting at least 1 minute for 1 hour**

2) Bleeding...more than a three (3) inch circle....bright red.

3) If your bag of waters has broken (rupture of membranes) especially if:

**** You see meconium (green or yellow staining).**

**** Culture of the cervix done during pregnancy showed the streptococcus (strep) bacteria. (GBS+)**

**** The baby is breech or not head first.**

**** If this occurs during the day, please call the office.**

4) Significant decrease in fetal movement.

5) Please notify the physician on-call of any problems you have had during your pregnancy such as:

****Breech at your last office visit.**

****Prior cesarean section.**

****Diabetes**

****High blood pressure.**

****History of fast labors.**

****Genital herpes.**

****Positive strep cultures. (GBS+)**
